

Foil Pictures

Age: 3-6 years



What's needed

Permanent felt-tip markers
Aluminum foil

What to do

1. Tear off paper-size (8 ½ - 1 inch) sheets of aluminum foil.
2. Have children draw on the foil with felt-tip markers.
3. Foil may be crumpled and flattened before, during, or after the drawing if the children wish.

Variation: Place the aluminum foil on a warm heating tray. With supervision, have children draw on foil using crayons. Crayons will slightly melt as children draw.

CAUTION

Teacher needs to supervise the use of the warming tray.
