

Producing a Play

Age: 5-10 years

What's needed

Book or story
Props or costumes that children can “make” or improvise with to act out the play



What to do

1. Children pick a story from a well-known book to act out.
2. Children develop script and make props or costumes from available materials.
3. Children choose specific characters and roles.
4. Children present the play for parents or make a video that could be loaned to parents for viewing or watched when parents pick up children.
